



Cooking Guidelines

Marking Guidelines

Each patrol will be asked to cook a simple meal using the equipment provided. Marks will be awarded for hygiene, cooking ability, best use of ingredients, ingenuity and safety. Each patrol must bring the following ingredients only and use some or all of them:

*2 x large potatoes
half an onion
1/4 lb of mince meat
2 x rashers of bacon
2 x carrots
knob of butter
herbs and spices of various types
sugar
flour
salt
cooking oil
few slices of thick bread
an egg*

Patrols will have 20 minutes to cook a meal of their choice with ONLY the above ingredients on a gas cooker. They will NOT have to do the washing up or clearing away (a leader will do this). Note that patrols must bring their own ingredients and these must ONLY be those listed above (they do not have to use all of them though). Patrols will NOT have to supply anything else (such as plates, forks, tea towels etc) - these will be provided.

Patrol

1. Teamwork
2. Good behaviour
3. Happy, positive outlook
4. Care taken with all the equipment

Safety & Hygiene

1. Patrols must demonstrate principles of safety and hygiene when cooking throughout the 20 minutes
2. Marks will be lost for serious breaches in hygiene or safety

Ingenuity and Recipe

1. Patrols will gain marks for ingenious use of ingredients
2. Patrols will gain marks for best use of the ingredients and for a good recipe well executed

Taste and Presentation

1. Patrols will gain marks for presentation and for taste of the finished product

Note:

Patrols are to spend the 20 minutes preparing and cooking the food.

They are NOT to do any cleaning or clearing up (other than that demanded by issues of hygiene or safety). This will be done by leaders to enable the patrols the maximum cooking time.

Washing up, clearing away and providing materials and cooking equipment will be the responsibility of the leaders running the base and should not impact on the patrols score.

Please try and follow these guidelines when marking each patrol

Please use the blank sheets available to construct your own marking scheme (i.e. give full details of what you awarded marks for)

You must score the Cooking base out of 100 points

Please make a note of your chosen criterion and the points available for future reference
