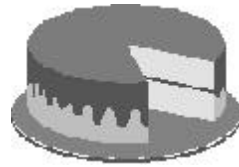


## Sponge Cake Recipe

- 8 oz (220 grams) Self Raising Flour (Sifted)
- 2 Teaspoons baking powder
- 8 oz Soft margarine or butter
- 8 oz Castor Sugar
- 4 Eggs (size 4)
- 4-6 Drops of vanilla essence



### Method

1. Cream fat and sugar until light and fluffy
2. Beat eggs, then slowly add a little at a time to the creamed mixture. If 'curdling' occurs, add 2-3 teaspoons of flour
3. Gradually fold in the flour
4. Add essence and if the mixture does not drop from a spoon easily then add a little milk
5. Place in a cake tin and put in an oven preheated to Gas Mark 4 (350 °F / 180 °C)

**Note:** No other ingredients should be added to the mixture but the top of the cake can be decorated once cooked and cooled.

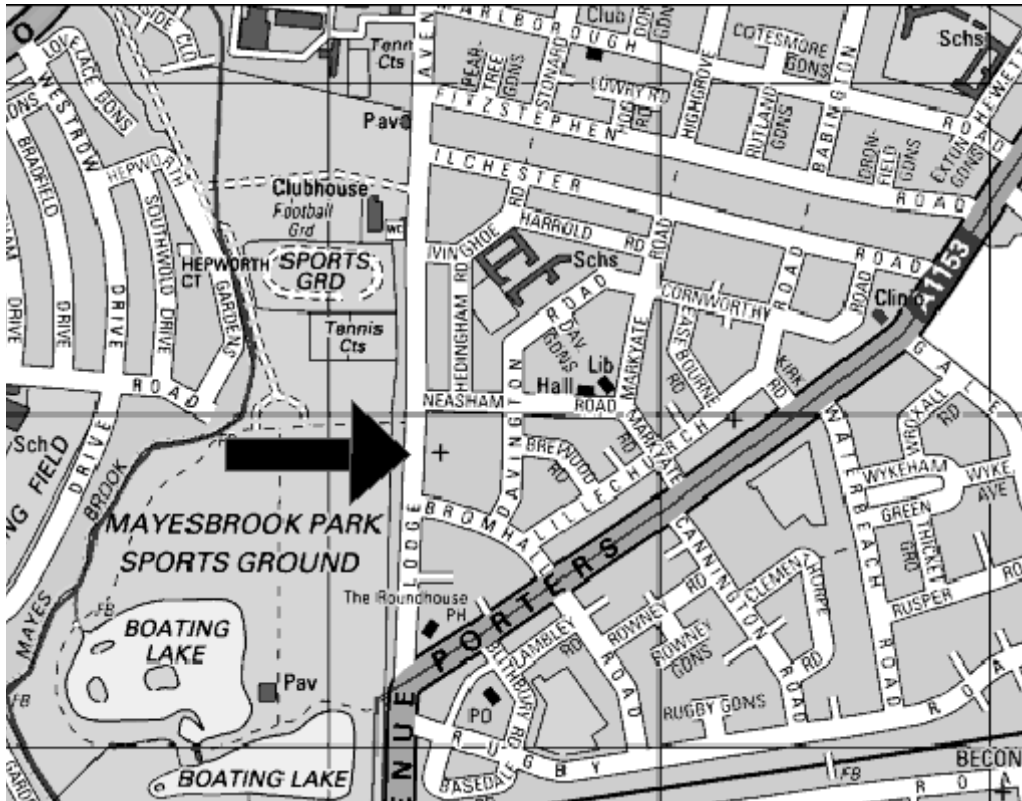

## Classes

Classes 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 8, & 9 apply to all age groups.

1. **6 Mounted Photographs** (A2 size)  
(must be the cub's own work)
  2. **Fabric Pencil Case**
  3. **Decorated Fabric** (max A4 size)  
Group A Under 9½ - Using Sponge Printing  
Group B Over 9½ - Using Potato Printing
  4. **Decorated Wooden Spoon**
  5. **Home-made Cakes**  
Group A Under 9½ - 4 Small Cakes  
Group B Over 9½ - 1 Large Cake
  6. **Greetings Card of your choice** (A5 , e.g. Single sheet of A4 folded in half)
  7. **Model - Key Rack from any material** (A5 footprint)
  8. **Home-made Musical Instruments** (A4 footprint)
  9. **Any Other Exhibit** (A5 footprint)
- Pack Effort      Solar System** (45 x 45 x 45 cm)
- Scouters Exhibit      1 Large Cake**



## Rules

- Group A:** Cubs Under 9½ years of age  
**Group B:** Cubs Over 9½ years of age

1. Age is determined on the day of the competition
2. Cub Scouts may enter every class, but may only submit **one** item per class
3. All entries should be marked with the Cub's name, scout group/pack name and age group on the back or underside of the work
4. Exhibits must have been made in the last nine months
5. Every item entered must be the Cubs own work
6. All items must conform to the size limits.

Any entries found not conforming to the rules or the spirit of the competition & scouting may be disqualified.

## Notes

We would be grateful if you could leave your entries and go. This will enable the District team to arrange and display them ready for judging in the morning.

Please follow the recipe given for the sponge cakes (see back page).

Please clearly mark the entries with the correct age group...Either Group A or Group B. Please do **not** mark the child's age in years.

An A5 footprint means that the item should fit onto a sheet of A5 paper **without affecting other exhibits** nearby or overhanging the paper base (I.e. it must be approximately 15 width x 20 length x 30 height)

Please find the time to visit the exhibition on the Saturday. Anyone may view the exhibits and all are invited to stay and support their group (Cubs & Scouts) when the certificates, awards and trophies are presented.
