

## Rules applicable to all sections

### Identification

Each competitor must wear their Group scarf and a card (minimum size 8" x 5" or 21 cm x 13 cm, **not** be covered in plastic) worn on their top garment at the front, clearly showing their Group name, section letter and their own name. For example:

Group A

### Equipment & Footwear

All equipment is provided for the events. Only trainers are to be worn. No spikes will be allowed.

### Heats

The number of heats for any event will be determined by the number of competitors.

### Use of the Arena

**Only** race officials, competitors and leaders are allowed in the arena.

**Only** those wearing a Group, Fellowship or District scarf will be allowed into the arena. Anyone in the arena must wear a scarf at all times. **This will apply to everyone, parents and leaders.**

**All** spectators (family, friends etc.) are to use the grandstand.

**No** ball games or bikes will be allowed in the arena.

**All** groups are to bring black rubbish bags in order to dispose of their rubbish.

**All** groups are to provide their own First-Aid kits.

All groups are asked to help organize, set up and run the Sports Day. They are also asked to help clear away and tidy the arena before leaving.

### Disqualification

Any Group or individual not complying with the rules will be disqualified from the race or event in question. If you have a query or question please take it up with the organizing team. Do not question the decision of the judges and adjudicators.

### Presentations

All Beaver Scouts must be in uniform in time for the presentations at the end of the day. Please make sure that your Group stay to see **all** the presentations as this is only polite.

## HEATS & FINALS

## SECTIONS

**Group A:** Beavers Under 7 years of age

**Group B:** Beavers Over 7 years of age

Age is determined on the day of the competition

## BEAVER SECTION SPECIFIC RULES



### Age Ranges

Beaver events are split into two sections, based on the actual date of the Sports Day.

**Section A – Under 7's**

Over 6 years old and under 7 years old

**Section B – Over 7 's**

Over 7 years old and under 8 years old

Section A Beavers may compete in Section B providing that they stay in Section B throughout the sports meeting (they may not compete in both sections)

Section B Beavers **cannot** compete in Section A events.

Similarly older Beavers may be able to take part representing the Cub section. This means that they cannot enter any Beaver events.

### Events

Each Colony can enter as many Beavers per event as they choose. Each individual Beaver may not compete in more than 2 events (not including the relay).



### -Relay Race

Each Colony may only enter a single team. The team consist of four Beavers picked according to the following rules:

A minimum of two Beavers from section A  
A maximum of two Beavers from section B

E.g. 2A & 2B    OR    3A & 1B    OR    4A
